User's Guide

Thank you for purchasing *The United Methodist Hymnal Compact Disc Accompaniment Edition*. We trust you will find this edition to be helpful in both the local congregation and the larger community. Hopefully its use will greatly expand the opportunities for sharing the Hymnal's materials.

What is it?

This accompaniment edition of *The United Methodist Hymnal* is unlike any other to date. It is a collection of compact discs containing recordings of all the music in the Hymnal except Anglican-style chants. (See page 8 of this User's Guide to learn why these chants were omitted.) The discs include:

- Service Music (i.e., the musical settings for “A Service of Word and Table” and the “Baptismal Covenant Musical Responses,” which are found on pages 17-31 and 53-54 respectively of the pew edition of *The United Methodist Hymnal*)
- Hymns
- Canticle Responses (such as No. 74, “Canticle of Thanksgiving”; No. 205, “Canticle of Light and Darkness”; and No. 646 “Canticle of Love”)
- Psalter Responses (sung responses of the Psalms, which are found on pages 738-862)
- Amens (Nos. 897-904)

All music on the discs is recorded in the order that it appears in *The United Methodist Hymnal*. The selections were recorded exactly as you see them printed on the Hymnal page. For your convenience, some short hymns or choruses have

versions with extra repetitions; similarly, several hymns with multiple stanzas have shortened versions if you do not wish to sing the entire hymn; and several bilingual hymns contain two versions to accommodate slightly different syllabification of each language, allowing you to choose which language to sing.

The compact discs are recorded in a “split-track” format, with instruments separated to either the left or right channels (i.e., left or right speakers). This recording technique allows you to listen to both channels or to only one channel simply by turning the “balance” knob on your CD player. Instead of having one balance of instruments, you now have three from which to choose: left channel, right channel, or a mix of the two. The organ and a solo instrument are typically on the left channel, and the piano and a different solo instrument are typically on the right channel. The recording was made so that the music sounds best when both channels are playing, but this format allows for flexibility and personal preference. When listening to the CD recordings, you will experience the sounds of a variety of melody instruments, such as: flute, piccolo, oboe, saxophone, trumpet, cornet, flugal horn, French horn, violin, guitar, handbells, vibraphone, and sitar. Accompanying instruments include pipe organ, grand piano, electric piano, harpsichord, guitar, harp, handbells, strings, various percussion instruments, and kalimba. The use of a variety of instruments will hopefully enliven congregational singing, and in some instances, provide a more stylistically authentic rendition of multicultural selections.

What do you need to play the compact discs? First, you don’t have to purchase an expensive stereo or sound system. Depending upon your situation, a portable CD player (“boom box”) may suffice. Or, you may wish to purchase reasonably priced stereo components: a CD player, stereo amplifier, and two speakers. If your church owns a sound system, in all probability you can incorporate a component CD player into the existing setup. A carousel CD player (capable of housing up to five discs simultaneously) with programming capabilities would be ideal if you plan consistently to use multiple discs for worship services or other events.

Uses of the CDs

The compact disc recordings can be used in numerous settings and for a wide range of purposes. They are particularly valuable if your local church does not have a regular accompanist for choir rehearsals or worship services. The recordings will enable the congregation to sing the “old favorites” (as well as new hymns), psalm and canticle responses, and service music. In addition, appropriate selections could be chosen for use as opening and closing voluntaries, offertories, and special music.

Perhaps the church is unable to find someone to accompany the choir, or the accompanist cannot attend choir rehearsals on a regular basis. If you wish to use some of the Hymnal materials as choral repertoire, the recordings can provide the accompaniment for rehearsals and performance.

CD HYMNAL—USER’S GUIDE

Have you ever wished you could play Hymnal materials, complete with instrumental accompaniment, in locations away from the church building? Now you can! The compact discs could be used when church members lead worship at a nursing home; when visiting the homebound or those in hospitals; on camps and retreats; at church fellowship meetings and parties; and even for personal enjoyment in the privacy of your own car or home. In other words, wherever you can take a portable CD player, you can take the Hymnal on CD!

THE MUSIC

Hymns

In general, the hymn introduction is the last phrase, the last two lines, or the refrain of the hymn. If the hymn is short or a “new” hymn, you may hear the entire

hymn played as an introduction. Accompanying instruments (typically piano and organ) play the introduction alone, and melody instruments join when the congregation should begin singing.

The number of repetitions played corresponds to the number of stanzas printed in the Hymnal. In some cases, you will be able to choose an alternate version of a hymn tune. Should you wish to sing a hymn with more or less stanzas than the recorded version(s), check the Index of Tune Names (page 931 ff.) to see if the tune is sung to another text. If so, you may find the number of repetitions you desire with this other text. Because the rhythms of some tunes change slightly to accommodate different words and syllables, be sure to check this alternate selection to see if it fits with the text you intend to sing.

When listening to a hymn recording, you will notice a slight break between the stanzas. This pause is a “breathing point,” which will allow the singers to take a deep breath before they begin to sing the next stanza. Also note that a *ritard* (a gradual deceleration) always occurs near the end of a hymn, and that the final note is typically held slightly longer than written.

Fermatas () are generally observed, and the lengths notes are held vary depending upon the hymn. Because fermatas may be held for different durations, familiarize yourself with hymns containing fermatas before playing them with the singers. No. 314, “In the Garden,” and No. 338, “Where He Leads Me,” are examples of hymns with fermatas.

Regularly in the piano accompaniment, you will hear notes that are not notated in the Hymnal. This *arpeggiation* or use of chord inversions typically “fills in” the time duration of notes that are held for several beats. For example, in the refrain of No. 365, “Grace Greater than Our Sin,” the words “Grace, grace, God’s grace” are each held for three beats. The use of piano *arpeggiation* on these words helps to keep the rhythm moving, enabling the singers to feel the pulse of the

music and to know how long to sustain the words. Another reason for using these techniques is that the sound of sustained chords played on the piano decays or dies away, unlike chords played on the organ, which sustain as long as the notes on the keyboard are depressed.

The standard orchestration for hymns is solo cornet or oboe playing the melody and organ accompaniment on the left channel; and solo flute playing the melody and piano accompaniment on the right channel. As mentioned above, the compact discs have been recorded so that the sound is best when all instruments are playing (i.e., when the left and right channels are balanced). However, if you prefer the sound of the right or left channel alone, you may take advantage of the split-track format by adjusting the “balance” knob.

Service Music, Psalter and Canticle Responses, Amens

If the introduction for a Psalm, Canticle, Amen, or piece of service music is not printed in the Hymnal, a single chord is typically played in tempo as the introduction. For example, Response 1 of Psalm 33 (page 767 in the Hymnal) contains a four-note introduction, printed in small notes. However, Response 2 has no printed introduction. When listening to the recording of the second response, you will hear the opening chord (held for three beats) followed by a pause (a quarter rest). After the pause or “breathing point,” the congregation would begin to sing. The standard orchestration for service music, Psalter and Canticle responses, and Amens is the same as for hymns: left channel—organ accompaniment and solo cornet or oboe; right channel—piano accompaniment and solo flute.

Following the introductions, the Amens are played (and sung) only one time. Service music is played (and sung) as written in the Hymnal, either beginning with a chord or with a printed introduction.

Advanced preparation is required if you plan to use the Psalter and Canticle responses. These responses are recorded only once on the CDs. However, when the Hymnal indicates by a red “R” that a response is to be used several times, you

should program your CD player so it will play the exact number of repetitions required. For example, No. 83, “Canticle of God’s Glory,” contains four red “R’s” indicating that the response is to be played and sung four times. Program your CD player to repeat the response four times. You will need to push the “Pause” button after each response so the text may be read. Then push the “Play” button to begin the next musical response. If your CD player is not programmable, you may still use the responses. You would simply need to push the “Repeat” button on the player for additional repetitions.

One proven way of using Psalm and Canticle responses is to have a “cantor” (song leader) sing the initial response alone and then lead the congregation in singing it. The cantor leads the congregation in singing all successive responses. The spoken text may be read in one of three ways: the cantor reads the lightface print and the congregation reads the boldface; the text may be read by two groups, such as the right and left sections of the congregation; or the entire text may be read in unison. It is a good idea to rehearse Psalter and Canticle responses prior to their use in worship.

As briefly mentioned above, Anglican-style chants (chordal chants) have been omitted. This is because the singing and playing of chant is based on word accent rather than meter. In other words, each congregation could have a different rendering of the “pitched” text. The chant selections that are not included in the CD collection are:

- No. 82, “Canticle of God’s Glory”
- No. 91, “Canticle of Praise to God”
- No. 270, “The Lord’s Prayer”
- No. 406, “Canticle of Prayer”

While the “Doxology” and the “Gloria Patri” are traditionally considered service music because they are a part of the weekly worship service, they are printed in the main body of the Hymnal. Therefore, No. 70, “Glory Be to the Father,” No. 71, “Glory Be to the Father,” No. 94, “Praise God, from Whom All Blessings Flow,” and No. 95, “Praise God, from Whom All Blessings Flow,” are recorded in the same manner as other hymns and are to be used accordingly. Note that the recording of No. 621 may be used as the accompaniment to the “short meter” version of the hymn tune, OLD 100th, if that is the congregation’s customary “Doxology.”

Operating Instructions

Who should be responsible for selecting the appropriate discs and operating the CD player? Obviously, the person who leads the hymns and other music in worship should have some, if not all, control over the procedure. However, if someone in the congregation is electronically inclined, the song leader may wish to coordinate with this person. In any event, a specific person should be designated as the one in charge of the CD player’s operation.

All music used from the CD edition of the Hymnal should first be carefully reviewed by worship planners (i.e., the song leader and the pastor). Once the song leader is familiar with the nuances of the recordings, the next step is to rehearse the music with those who will be singing it. Why is a rehearsal important? The rehearsal helps everyone prepare to sing the music in the worship service. Introductions, tempos, fermatas, breathing points, and *ritards* become expected occurrences rather than surprises. In addition, if a hymn or other piece of music is new to the singers, a rehearsal provides the opportunity to teach it rather than “springing it on them” unprepared.

To locate a musical selection on the CDs, use the Index beginning on page 13 of this booklet. Find the correct disc in the case, place it in the CD player, select the appropriate track number(s), and press the “Play” button. Remember to program the CD player if you are using a Psalm or Canticle with repeated responses. Practice playing the responses with pauses for the text that will be read between the repetitions during worship.

If you need to use several discs for a worship service, consider using a carousel CD player. Carousel players can accommodate up to five discs at one time. These units can be programmed to play certain recordings in a certain order. They are also helpful for programming the multiple repetitions of Psalm and Canticle responses.

Care of the Discs

When handling a disc, use your thumb and forefinger, being careful to touch only the edges and the hole in the middle of the disc. Store the discs in the sleeves provided to help keep them in good condition. Keep the sleeves in order in the case to save time when looking for specific discs. If you need to clean the discs or the CD player, use a reputable commercial product designed especially for these purposes.

Summary

Once again, you are to be congratulated on your purchase of *The United Methodist Hymnal Compact Disc Accompaniment Edition*! This product and the technology that has made it possible have opened a new world of possibilities for using materials from the Hymnal. Now you are ready to begin exploring the Hymnal in a way unavailable in the past.

Obviously, defective discs will be replaced free of charge within the first year of ownership. Lost or damaged discs will be replaced for a cost of \$33.99 per disc.
